3. As a rule, the processing of personal data is carried out on the basis of necessity for the fulfillment of a contract (pursuant to Article 6 para. 1 lit. b) DSGVO. The contractual relationship is primarily the membership relationship in the association. Personal data is used for the organization of the membership (esp.
